



BELOW ZERO AWARD

Witauchsoman Lodge #44

During a camping trip when the temperature has dropped below zero degrees Celsius (thirty-two degrees Fahrenheit), a troop or patrol must fulfill the following requirements to earn this award.

1. Use proper winter camping techniques as stated in the Boy Scouts of America Fieldbook.
2. Sleep a minimum of one night in a tent or other temporary shelter.
Note: A permanent structure such as a cabin or Adirondack shelter is not permitted.
3. **The camping trip was not a district or council event.**
4. This must be done as an authorized Troop or Patrol Event.

For their outstanding courage to brave the outdoors, the unit will receive an Order of the Arrow Below Zero Award Ribbon for their unit flag. They may also purchase ONE special award patch per scout.
